## TSCA\* Supplier Declaration Hubbell Power Systems, Inc. Ripley Tools Division

Re: \*Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) / Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals under TSCA Section 6(h)

The Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, enacted on June 22, 2016, includes a provision under TSCA section 6(h) requiring EPA to take expedited action on specific PBT chemicals to address risk and reduce exposures to the extent practicable. EPA identified five PBT chemicals (listed below is Section A) for expedited action in 2016, following criteria outlined in section 6(h) of TSCA and issued a proposed rule in 2019. EPA issued final rules on January 6, 2021.

Pursuant to the statute, there is <u>no risk evaluation required</u> for the chemicals listed below in Section A. Ripley believes that none of our products supplied contain any of the identified PBT's in amounts that exceed thresholds as defined at https://www.epa.gov/assessing-and-managing-chemicals-under-tsca/persistent-bioaccumulative-and-toxic-pbt-chemicals-under.

## **Section A: 5 PBT Chemicals**

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)
